Many years ago, when I was new to Houston and before I worked at Stratford, I fell in with a community theatre. I worked tech and acted in several of their productions. We produced *Dracula* one year, and it was set in 1920s rural Louisiana...I have no idea why. I played the orderly Wesley who, to be kind, was not that bright. One night, backstage waiting for an entrance, I wasn't paying close attention and made a bold entrance two scenes too early. Seeing panic in the eyes of my fellow actors, I thought up a lie (and I thought it up quickly). I looked around and said, "Nope. Wrong room," turned around and marched out. The audience loved it. So after a round of apologies for missing my cue so badly, we decided to keep it.

I know what a play going wrong is like. I've lived it personally. I've seen in the eyes of a scene partner that they have no idea where they are in the script. I've had set pieces come crashing to the ground, I've had fog machines overheat, and I've had lights not work and then work in the wrong scene. If it can go wrong, short of bodily injury, I've seen it happen. When this play was suggested last year, my first thought was, "Why are we producing a live theatre documentary?"

Hopefully, the only things that go wrong in this performance are the ones we've planned for and rehearsed...but we're ready for anything.
